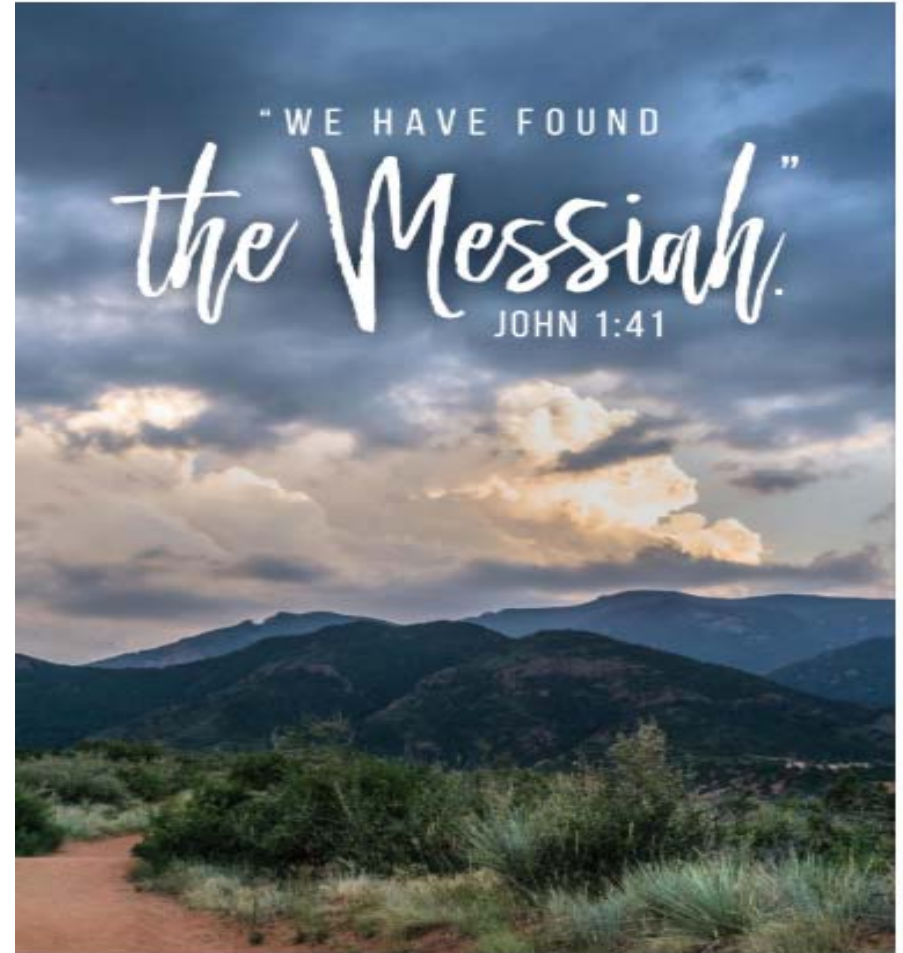

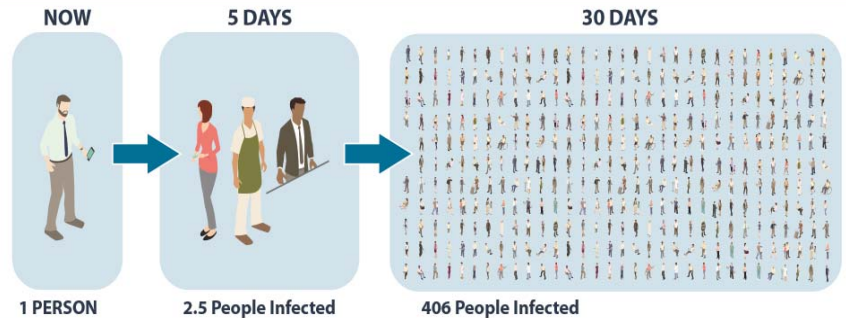
**Community Outreach Food Pantry** is collecting non-perishable food and dry goods. A box is in the parlor for your donation.

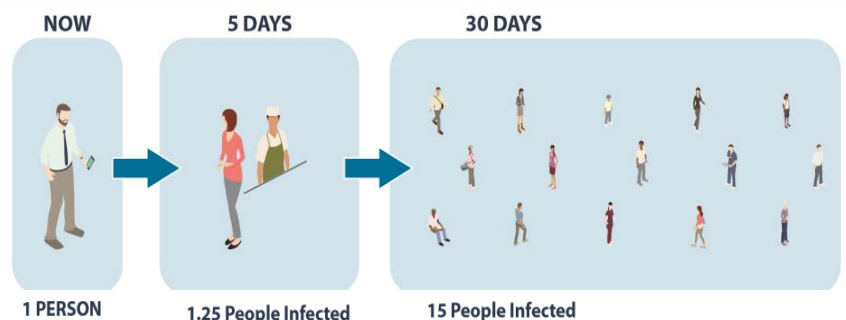

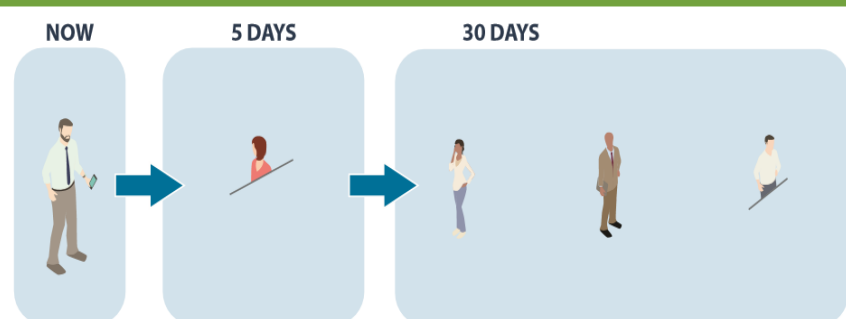
### IF YOU MAKE NO CHANGES IN BEHAVIOR

(24:1- 7) Then the whole assembly rose and led him off to Pilate. <sup>2</sup> And they began to accuse him, saying, "We have found this man subverting our nation. He opposes payment of taxes to Caesar and **claims to be Messiah, a king.**"

<sup>3</sup> So Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the king of the Jews?"

<sup>23</sup> But with loud shouts they insistently demanded that he be crucified, and their shouts prevailed. <sup>24</sup> So Pilate decided to grant their demand. <sup>25</sup> He released the man who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, the one they asked for, **and surrendered Jesus to their will.**
