Pause: Just Sit there – dwell in the gospel

Luke 10:38-42

So, Paul in that moment declares the wonders of the Gospel. God creates hope for our tomorrow.

Today’s key for dealing with hardship:

Pause, Just sit there and contemplate with gratefulness as to the forgiveness, power and hope that God has given us within the Gospel.

Final Thought:

Keep the sound teaching with faith and love Christ Jesus, Guard the gospel with the help of the Holy Spirit that lives within us.
