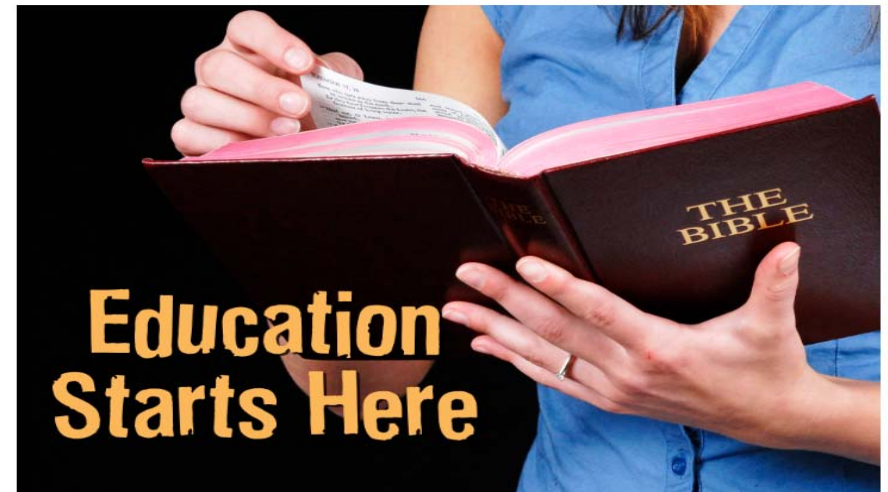

Request for Volunteers:

Are you interested in volunteering to help with a food distribution program for children for @2 hours for one, two or three days a week? Are you willing to serve as the coordinator or partner with someone?

Situation: Our YMCA has a Grant from the USDA to serve meals to children. They, in cooperation with our schools, were feeding @ 1000 students per day, breakfast and lunch. The schools stopped serving meals May 22nd, so the Y is now doing all preparation and distribution.

Their Proposal: To begin June 1; Set up four more distribution points around town for kids to pick up the meals from @11am-12:30pm on Monday, Wednesday & Friday. (Pine Street Baptist, First Presbyterian Church and the United Methodist Church have already agreed to help.) The Y will deliver the packaged meals to the distribution points between 10-10:30am. Then a crew of volunteers will receive and hand out the meals. The Monday and Wednesday distribution will supply food for two days. The Friday delivery will supply food for three days. After the serving period, the Y will come back to pick up remaining food.

The program will run from June through August.

If we have enough volunteers to form teams of 2-4 people each day, we will work from the west side of the Fellowship Hall with open air distribution, or inside during harsh weather.

IF our group has enough volunteers to assemble the meals, the Y would deliver food in bulk for assembly at the location, but that is not a requirement.

There will be an organizational meeting Sunday, May 31, at 2:00 pm in the FCC Fellowship Hall. Please enter through the south or west entrance. If you cannot make it to the meeting but are interested in helping, please contact David Rorabaugh by phone or text at 417-549-0670.
