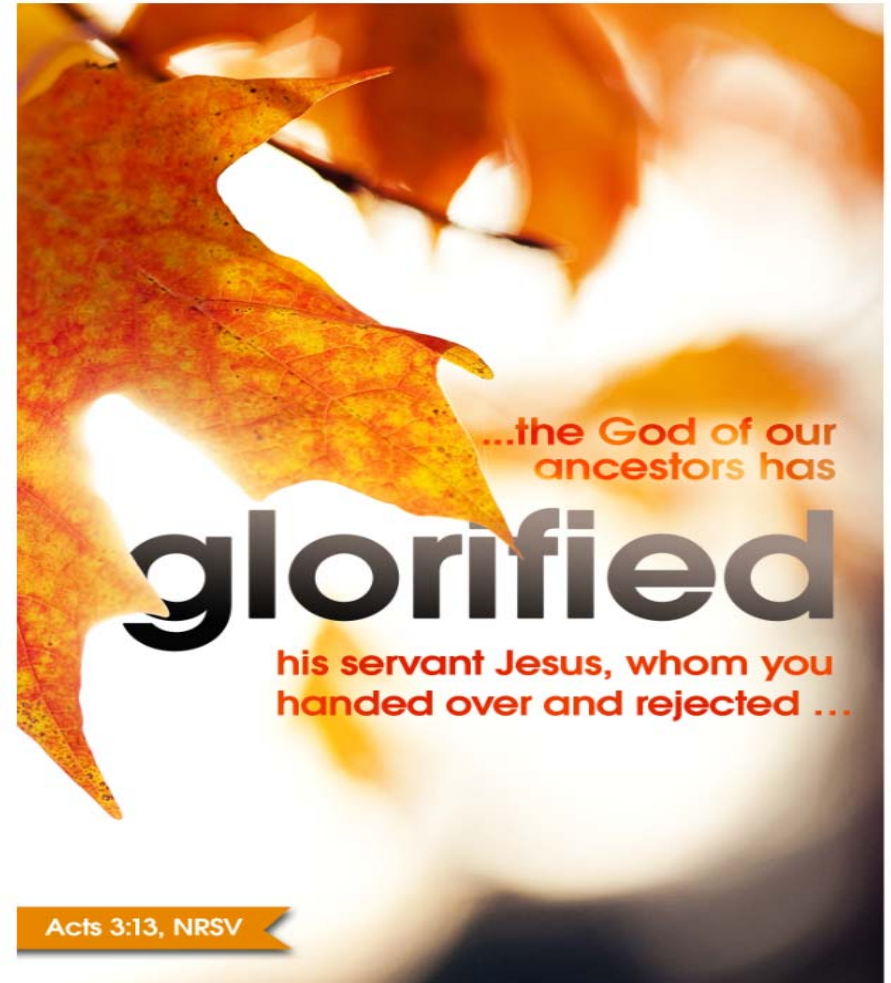

**Acts 3:1-8** Then Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. **In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.**"<sup>7</sup> Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong.<sup>8</sup> He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God.
