Changes in the Back Packs of Love Program: For the foreseeable future, or at least for the 2020-2021 school year, the Back Packs of Love Program is being discontinued. Instead, school children will receive food another way.

Using a USDA grant program, the Osage Prairie YMCA will be distributing food from a centralized location. Although all the details have not yet been worked out, children would receive seven days of 3 meals per day once a week. If you currently donate to the Back Packs of Love program, you may want to take a pause. The money that is in the FCC account will remain there until the Back Packs of Love program is resumed. Please watch for further information. As the details are developed, we may be asking for your help with distribution efforts.
