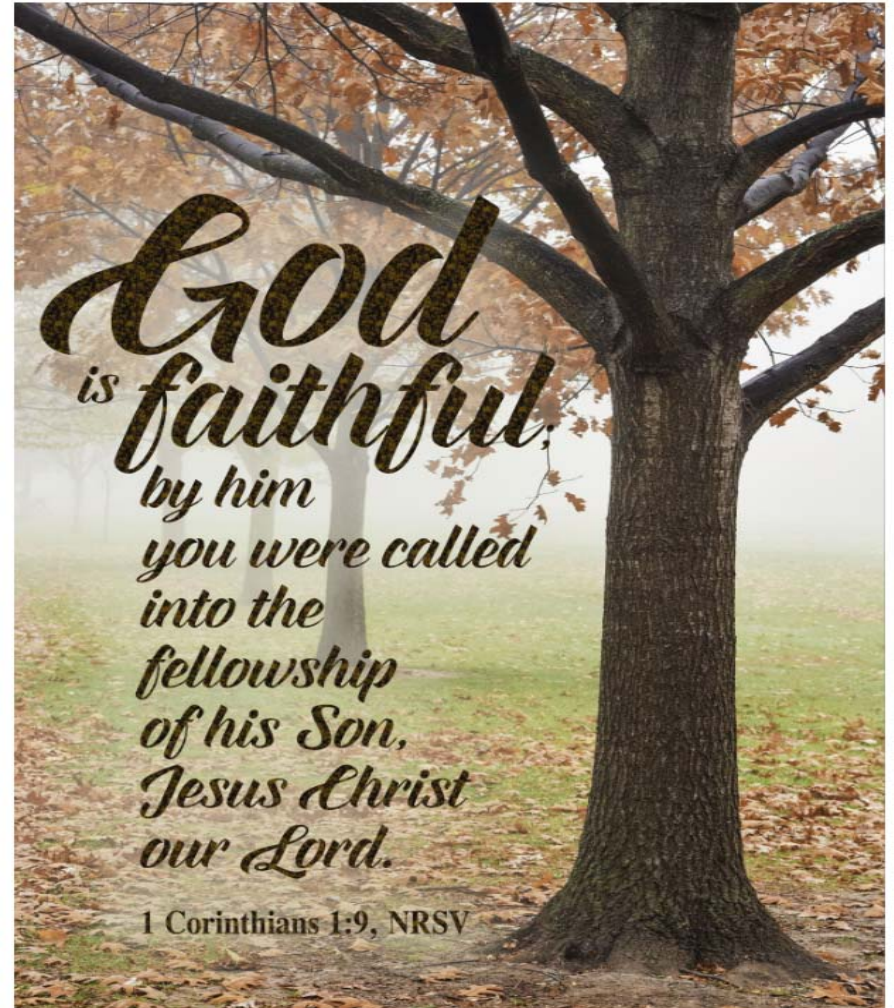

The 2020 LIFE CHAIN, a nationally recognized Pro-life Prayer Chain is scheduled for **Sunday, October 4, from 2:00 to 3:00 pm.** Participants will stand along Austin Boulevard in front of the FCC Fellowship Hall to hold signs in support of Pro-life. The Food Distribution Program to area students has begun and volunteers are needed.

Using a USDA grant program, the Osage Prairie YMCA will be distributing bags containing seven days of 3 meals per day from the YMCA on Sundays. **At present, almost 700 children are signed up so that means that close to 1400 bags must be filled. The bags are packed on Saturdays from 1:00 to approximately 3:45 pm. Our help is needed on Saturdays.** The plan is to have enough people from enough churches participating so that each church would work **only one shift per month, or perhaps only every two months.** If you would like to volunteer to help pack food in bags on Saturdays at the YMCA, please sign up on the sheet provided in the Parlor at the Welcome Center or call the church office at 417-667-3540.
